



Uniform Policy

At Southbridge, we value a child's ability to concentrate. Our dress code supports focus in all learning spaces — indoor and outdoor.

Basic Guidelines

No commercial characters • No rips or holes • No words, patterns, or numbers

Brand logos no larger than 2 inches (e.g. a small Nike logo is acceptable)

Clothing should fit well and look neat

Label EVERYTHING

Tops

- Plain collared shirt
- Neutral colors examples: navy, light blue, black, tan, green, maroon, grey, or white
- No fluorescent colors
- Sweatshirts (not baggy)

Bottoms

- Navy, khaki, or black
- Pants — no sweatpants
- Girls may wear uniform-style dresses, jumpers, skirts, or skorts (uniform plaid is fine)
- Leggings can be worn under a dress/skirt/skort

Indoor Shoes

- Kept at school all year
- Closed toe
- Wraps around the ankle
- Hard sole
- No light-up, high heels, or wheels
- 5 day students - recommend gym shoes be used as indoor shoes

We go outside in all weather — please dress your child accordingly. Rainboots and snow boots are highly recommended. There is no bad weather, just bad clothes!
